### **Topic 2: Review 2009 Minutes**

- 2) Other NE clubs want to join the NMA.  
Jim had a Gary Arand contact him about the NMA.  
\*Jim M. to contact Gary Arand for more info. about what type of program he runs.
- 3) Bill S. talked about Creighton's junior program – can we get them into the NMA.  
\*Bill R. will contact them for PR. \*Bill R talked about the Offutt gun clubs.

### **Topic 3: Treasure Report**

Don Albright presented a copy of the 2009 NMA Register Report.

- 1) The bank charging us \$7.15 for service fees?  
\*Jim M will ask or talk to the bank about why we are getting charged this.
- 2) Don recommends there is nothing which looks out of place in the 2009 report.
- 3) Discussion by Gene. Where and why was there \$148.40 spent. Jim explained that this fee is for the money the NRA wants.
- 4) Where the money went for juniors. Jim explained the \$50. We deferred this to new business.
- 5) Treasurers report accepted.

#### **Topic 5: New Business**

1) How to get more smallbore kids to shoot.

How do we get more people (juniors and others) in to shooting sports, and how to make shooting fun for kids and parents?

Jim M added that he has a list of juniors who are active in program in building.

2) Motion is to form a committee to determine: what are the activities which offer juniors and other to promote shooting sports.

\*Bill R will put together this document.

#### **Topic 6: Funding for Juniors**

1) Jim M – put a motion for up to \$300 for air rifles juniors to fund their travel to national events.

Jim would like to provide some funding help to these shooting teams.

This is the same vote from 2009 for \$500- but only needs to be \$300 – Thus lowering the 2010 amount.

Motion accepted the use of up to \$300.

2) A follow up motion was: do we ask that the person/club be a member of the NMA. Motion fails. Vote: Ya = 4. nay = 12

\*Add to old business – bring this up in the 2011 meeting. *Does the NMA require the person or club to be a member of the NMA to receive funding?*

3) Gene K. – put a motion on the table to fund a specific junior (Richard Davison Jr) to go to Camp Perry Long Range. – Fund up to \$60 for registration.

Vote – accepted.

Don A. noted that we do not want to set precedence for ALL. Each request will be reviewed and determined if funding is warranted.

#### **Topic 7: Firearm Inventory**
